

Stadtwerk Cup: Rules and format

Latest update on 30 October 2019

1. The matches are played according to the official rules of the International Handball Federation, the European Handball Federation and the Swiss Handball Federation.
2. The playing time is 2 x 30 minutes with a break of 15 minutes.
Each team is allowed to request 3 team time outs (60 seconds) per game.
3. There are four teams participating in the tournament, at which the teams play each other once during the three days. Finally, there will be a ranking over the whole tournament.
4. In case of two teams having the same number of points at the end of the tournament, the following criteria decide:
 - a) goal difference (in the whole tournament)
 - b) result against the team with the same amount of points
 - c) greater number of goals scored (in the whole tournament)
 - d) drawing lots
5. 16 players are allowed to play in each match.
6. In the case of an identical team colour, the second team mentioned in the match report changes the outfit.
7. A player who is disqualified for the rest of the game (red and blue card) is not allowed to play in the following match in any case.
8. In special cases the Arbitration Board decides:
referee supervisor, administration match operations, 2 representatives of the teams.
